

Pupil Premium Funding 2016 - 2017

The Academy was allocated £112,200 in respect of 85 eligible pupils.

What we allocated our funding to:

Intervention

- We employed experienced and qualified teachers to teach Literacy and Numeracy Booster Groups in Years 2, 5 and 6
- We had a designated member of staff delivering SEN interventions in Key Stage 1.
- We maintained a high level of trained and experienced Teaching Assistants delivering small group and 1:1 Literacy and Numeracy interventions.
- The learning Hub provided interventions to improve meta-cognition and self-regulation.

Support

- Our Pupil Welfare Assistant supported pupils experiencing social and emotional issues.
- We contributed towards uniform and equipment costs.
- We ran Shared Learning Events where parents came in to school to learn alongside their children.
- We provided a breakfast club, supervised by our experienced Sports and PE leader which promoted healthy eating, exercise, collaboration and teamwork.
- We invited a trainee play therapist to complete her training on site, providing Therapeutic Play sessions for some Key Stage 1 and 2 pupils.

Enrichment

- Subsidised places were made available to pupils to enable them to participate in a wide range of enrichment activities
- We actively encouraged pupil participation in extra-curricular and enrichment activities
- We contributed to out of school activities such as swimming lessons, music lessons, football club and holiday clubs
- Forest Schools for Year 1 and Year 6 to develop self-esteem, self-belief and resilience.
